Originally founded in 1968 as Four County Technical Institute, NSCC began offering classes in 1969. The College moved to its current location and was renamed Northwest Technical College in 1972, and in 1994 we became a community college. As we proudly celebrate 50 years of service to our six-county area, NSCC is as focused as ever to train and educate our students to improve families and communities through family-sustaining wages. The College is also guided by a strong Strategic Plan to ensure sustained excellence for generations to come.


